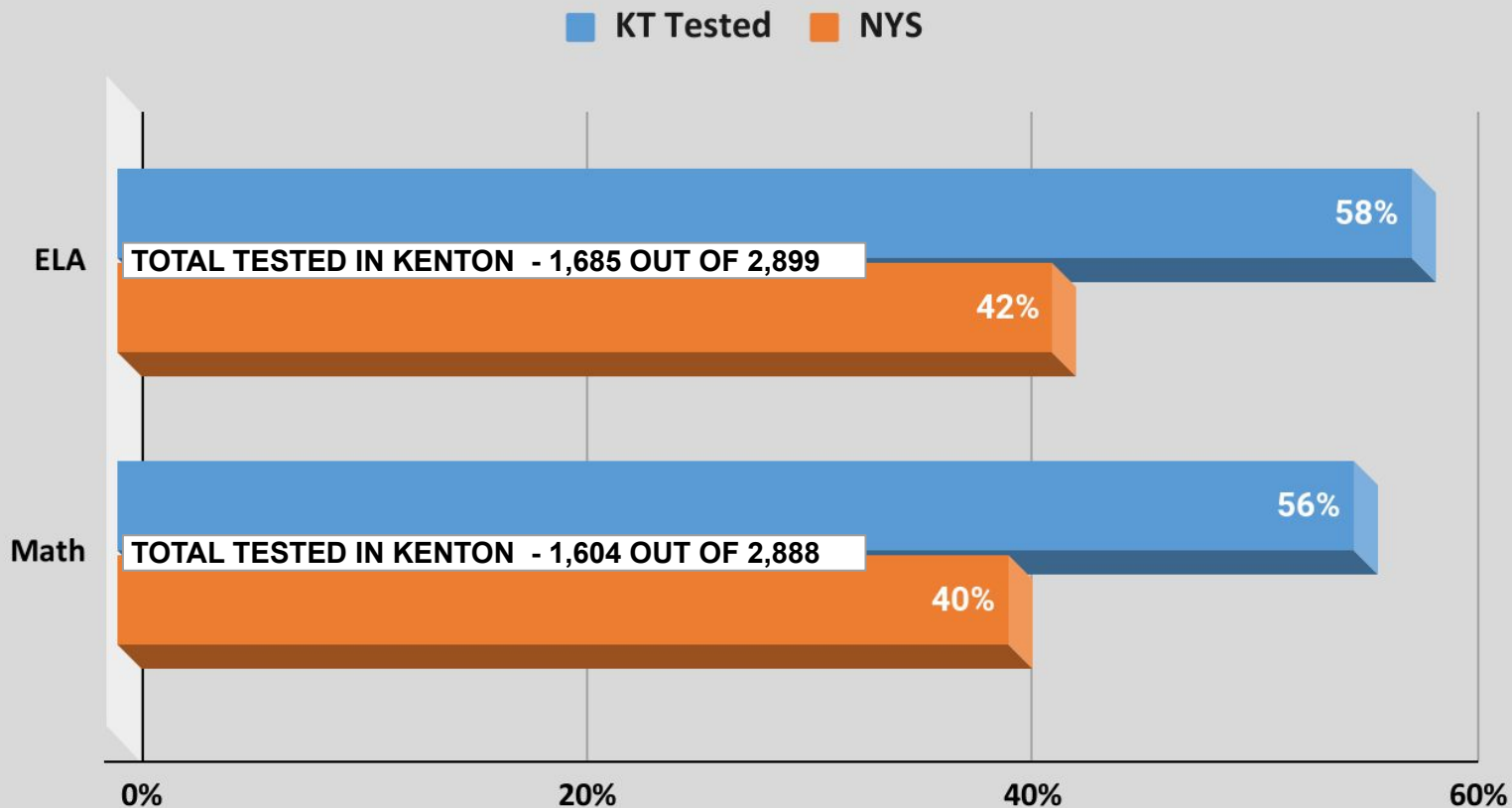

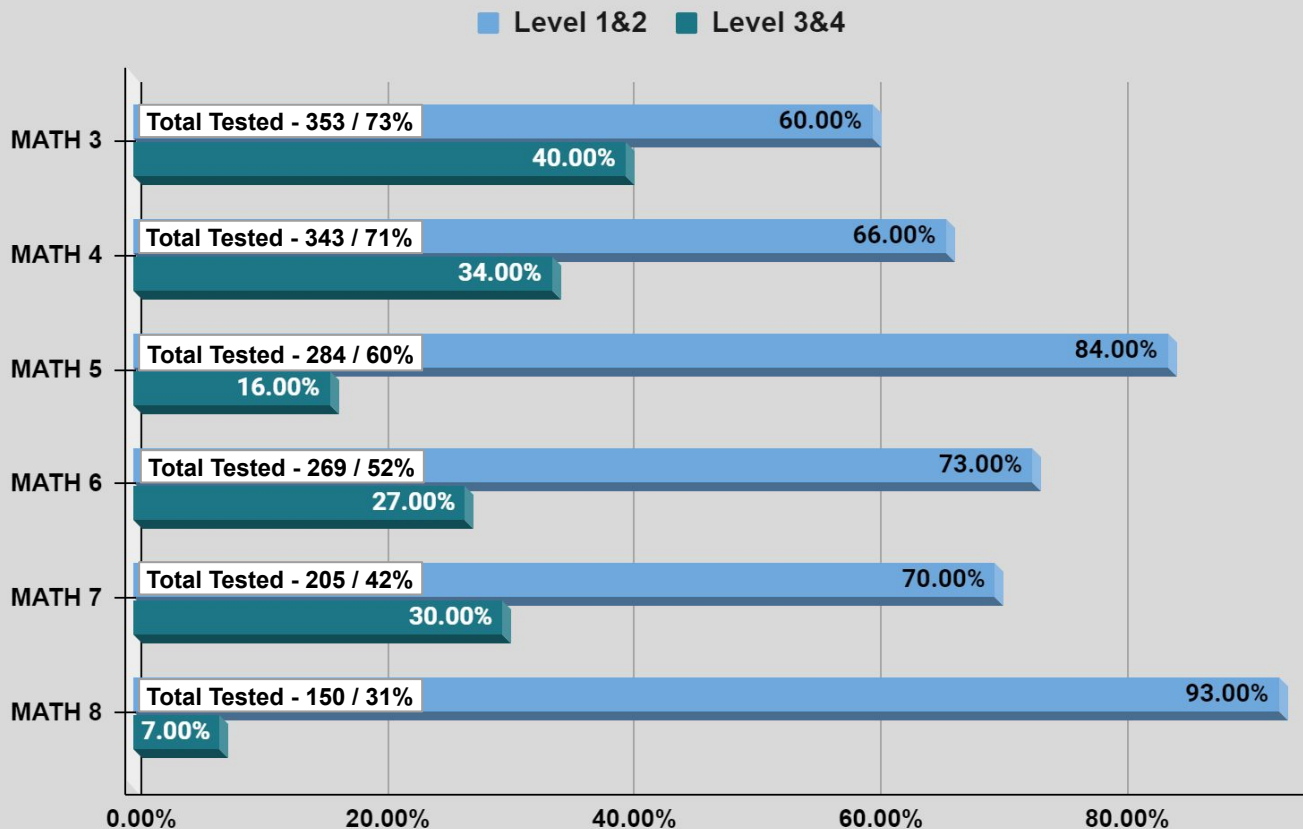

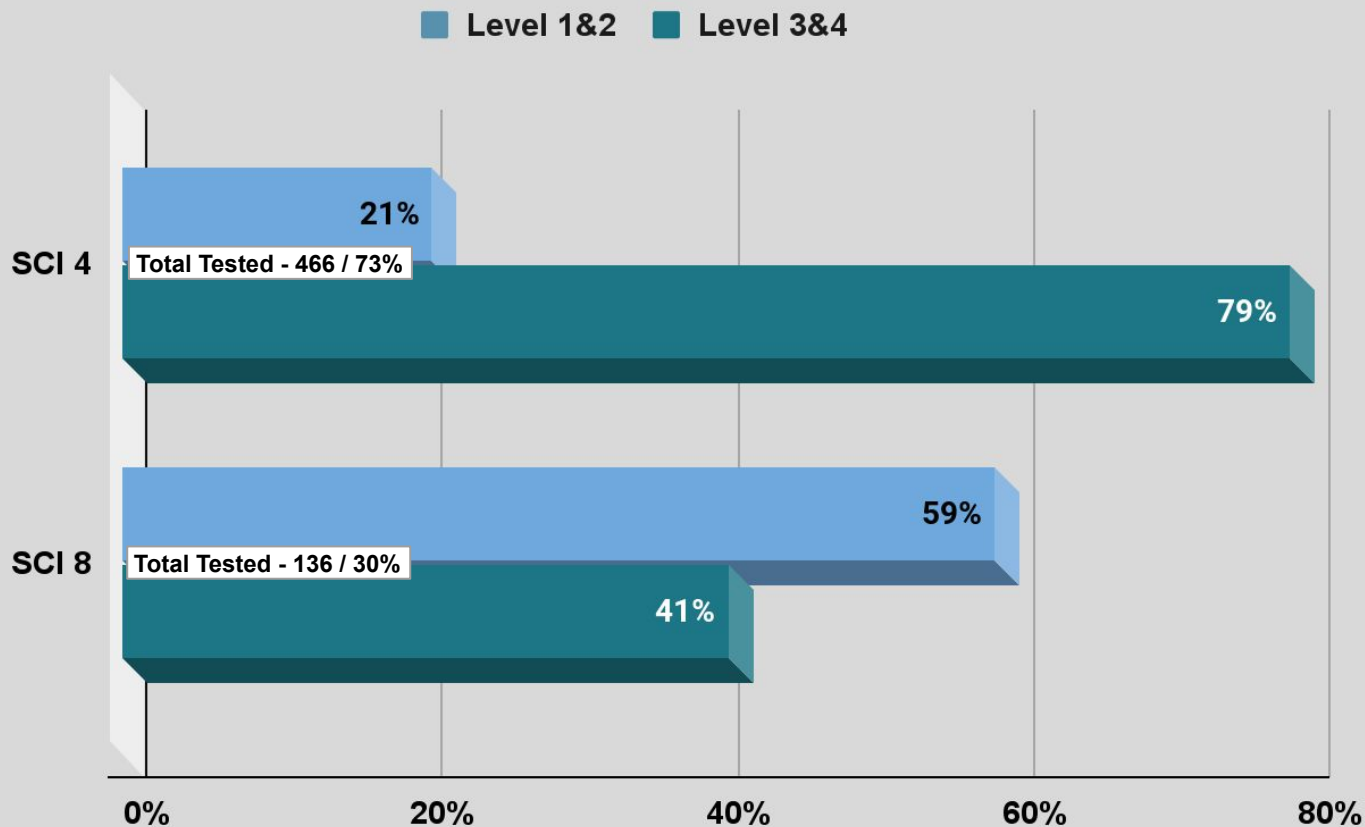

# District Graduation Rates

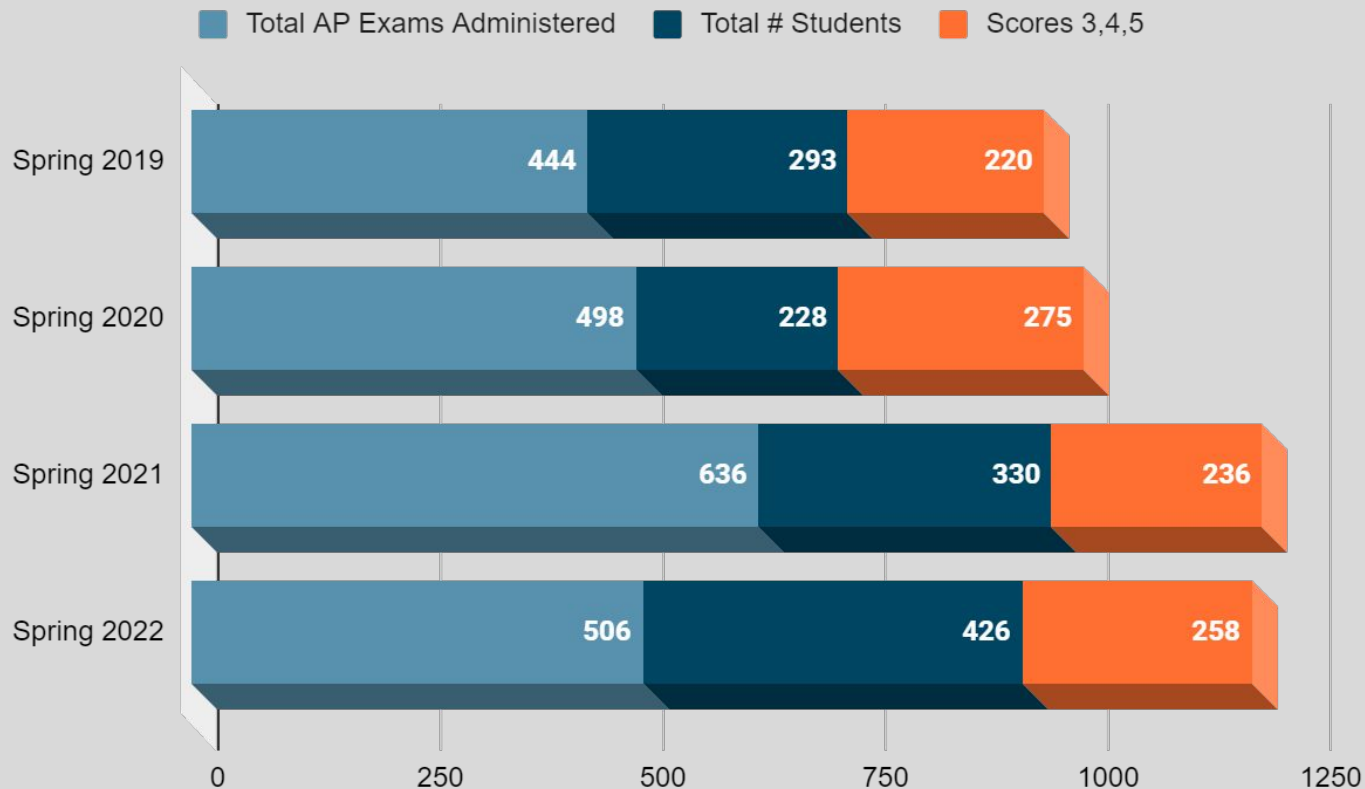
