



- Absent 10% or more of days enrolled For students enrolled in Gr. K 12
- ♦ 180 School Days = 18 days or more 10%
- NYS excluded suspensions and extended medical absences from chronic absenteeism calculation

Average Daily Attendance % by YearDistrict Total


