


Capital Project Priorities & Investments



The Capital Project encompasses the following proposed priorities and investments at Edison Elementary School:

- A four-classroom addition which will address the need for additional classroom space
- New bus loop for loading/unloading, which will remove all buses from the streets in order to enhance safety and address traffic concerns during arrival/dismissal
- New parent drop-off/pick-up lane to further enhance safety and address traffic concerns
- Reconstruction of athletic field
- Renovations for a more secured Single Point of Entry
- · Replacement of drinking water pipes to maximize water quality
- New carbon monoxide detection system
- Replacement of decades-old windows


