




Team teaching, I.B.M. report cards, advanced placement classes—East is changing!

Leave school at noon? Why certainly, if you're a member of the work study program. This year fifty seniors and twenty juniors participated in this course. A minimum of twelve credits was necessary to enter the program, and participants received a credit for the work study class and a credit and grade from their employers.

Large scale teaching was expanded to include typing along with history and all of the sciences. Special guest speakers, such as Professor Gerhard Falk and Mr. Laszlo Szabo, added interest to the team teaching history classes.

After wading through more than 1000 college applications for the class of '66, the guidance department led the class of '67 on the same path through individual counseling. Visiting college representatives aided them by giving the students glimpses of college life.

Seniors relied heavily on the guidance staff to help them in their college selection and application. Through visiting college representatives, students gained knowledge of life on the campus. As the school year ends, we look back to the dedication of our counselors with gratitude.

It was the Juniors who fully experienced the intense excitement and suspense surrounding the Student Forum election. However, for the Seniors, it will always be "Happy Days are Here Again" and "vending machines in the cafeteria" which constituted the best campaign ever.

In the spring, the Sophomores culminated all their talent and energy in a terrific variety show. By plunging into academics, dramatics, Student Forum, athletics, and many clubs, they became known and respected.

The entire student body showed that it could perform as a unit in November when the Blue-Gold weekend car parade and float competition attracted more participants than any of East's previous big weekends.






To each member of the senior class of 1966, then, we extend our congratulations for an excellent contribution, and our best wishes for success in the pursuits that will follow graduation.
