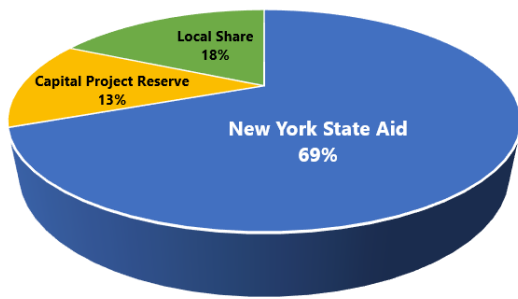

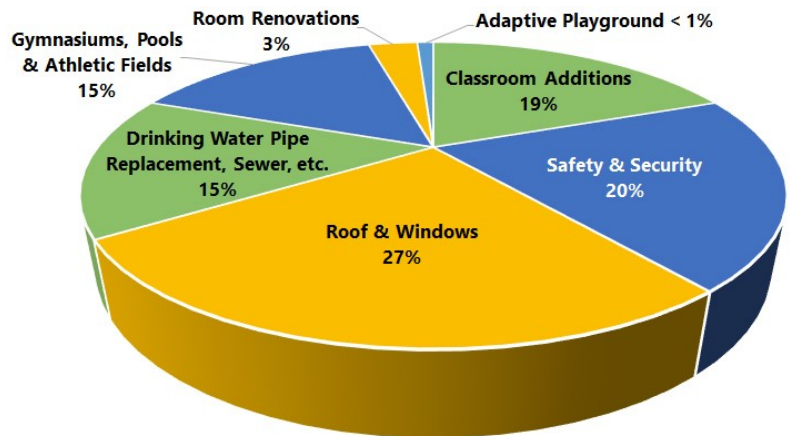

If approved, this project will be funded primarily through New York State Education Department Building Aid, with additional funding from the district's capital reserve. Capital Project Priorities & Investments

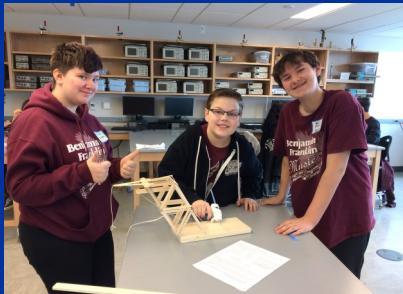


The Capital Project encompasses the following proposed priorities and investments at Franklin Elementary & Middle School:

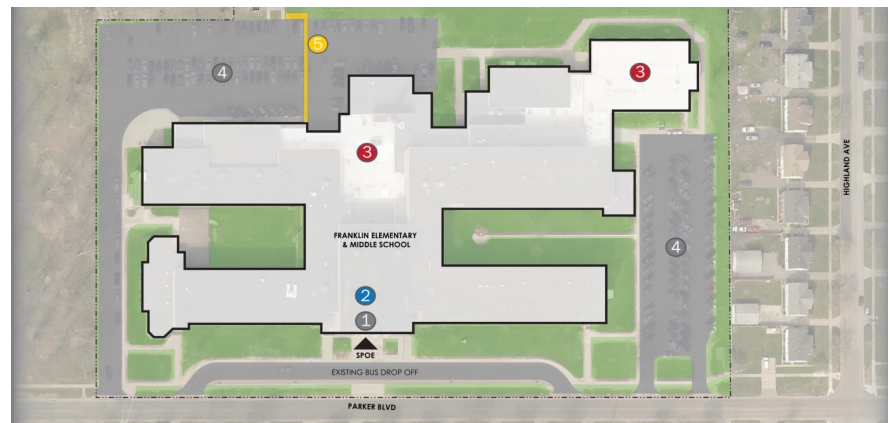
- Renovations for a more secured Single Point of Entry
- Replacement of drinking water pipes to maximize water quality
- New carbon monoxide detection system
- Partial roof replacement (middle school side of the building)
- Renovations and upgrades to the middle school gymnasium
- Reconstruction of parking lots and sidewalks
- New single-occupant unisex restrooms
- New “Baker”-style pool drains to enhance swimmer safety
