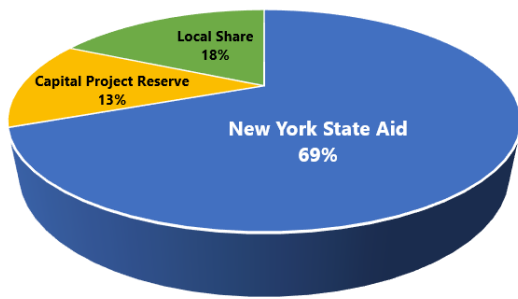
# CAPITAL PROJECT

Vote 7 a.m. — 9 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 5, 2020 at Hoover Middle School



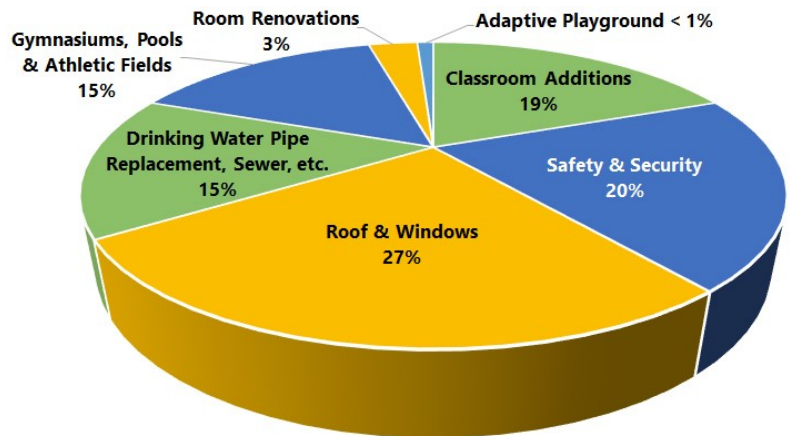

If approved, this project will be funded primarily through New York State Education Department Building Aid, with additional funding from the district's capital reserve. ## Capital Project Priorities & Investments



The Capital Project encompasses the following proposed priorities and investments at Kenmore East High School:

- New artificial turf athletic facility, including baseball, softball, and multipurpose (e.g. soccer, lacrosse) fields
- New student pick-up/drop-off zones to enhance safety and address traffic concerns during arrival/dismissal
- Renovations for a more secured Single Point of Entry
- Replacement of drinking water pipes to maximize water quality
- New carbon monoxide detection system
- Partial roof replacement
- Reconstruction of parking lots and sidewalks
- New single-occupant unisex restrooms
- New “Baker”-style pool drains to enhance swimmer safety



The proposed Capital Project will also encompass a new adaptive/inclusive playground at a site to be determined and work at other school buildings.
